PREPARATION FOR COUNTERTOP INSTALLATION

Removal all drawers from all lower cabinets.

Empty all contents from all lower cabinet.

Have sink removed; ensure you have working hot and cold shut off valves for sinks. Or make arrangements with your Sales person for your installer to remove and/or install your sink and if needed install shut offs.

Installers have to bring countertops into your home please try to have clear access for them.

Your installers will instruct you on any precautions to be taken after a new installation.

Such as:

Do not put anything heavy on the seams (if you have any) of your newly installed countertops for at least 48 hours. eg. Microwave or Coffeepots. The weight or the heat will interfere with the glue drying.

Keep water off seams and caulking for at least 24 hours.

A Stove at the incorrect height will damage the end caps of your new countertop. The installer will explain the correct height if you are unsure.

PLEASE NOTE

Installers do their best and take care to remove and install without damage to paint or tiles. However, minor damage does occur unfortunately.

Installation includes cutting ONE standard sinkhole only. Faucet hole is not included in the installation.
